Who we are

This website is operated by Z&A Exchange OÜ trading as Bitfin.io. Z&A Exchange OÜ is a duly incorporated Estonian private limited company with registration number 14506364 licensed and regulated by the Estonian Financial Intelligence Unit (FIU).

Our website

This cookie policy only relates to your use of our website, bitfin.io.

Throughout our website we may link to other websites owned and operated by certain third parties to make additional products and services available to you. Cookies

A cookie is a small text file which is placed onto your device (eg computer, smartphone or other electronic device) when you use our website. We use cookies and other similar tracking technologies such as web beacons, action tags, single-pixel gifs on our website. These help us recognise you and your device and store some information about your preferences or past actions.

For example, we may monitor how many times you visit the website, which pages you go to, traffic data, location data and the originating domain name of a user's internet service provider. This information helps us to build a profile of our users.

more effectively by providing interest-based advertisements that are

personalised to your interests; and

Types of cookies

The cookies we place on your device fall into the following categories:

Session cookies—these allow our website to link your actions during a

particular browser session. These expire each time you close your browser

and do not remain on your device afterwards

Persistent cookies—these are stored on your device in between browser

sessions. These allow your preferences or actions across our website to be remembered. These will remain on your device until they expire, or you delete

them from your cache



- Strictly necessary cookies—these cookies are essential for you to be able
 to navigate our website and use its features. Without these cookies, the
 services you have asked for could not be provided
- Performance cookies—these cookies collect information about how you use our website, eg which pages you go to most often. These cookies do not collect personally identifiable information about you. All information collected by these cookies is aggregated and anonymous, and is only used to improve how our website works
- Functionality cookies—these cookies allow our website to remember the
 choices you make (such as your user name, language, last action and search
 preferences) and provide enhanced, more personal features. The information
 collected by these cookies is anonymous and cannot track your browsing
 activity on other websites
- Targeting cookies—also known as advertising cookies, these cookies are used to deliver adverts more relevant to you and your interests. They are also used to limit the number of times you see an advertisement on our website and help measure the effectiveness of the advertising campaign. They are usually placed by advertising networks with the website operator's permission. They remember that you have visited a website and this information is shared with other organisations such as advertisers.
